Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(University of Tennessee Campus Area) Neyland Drive Lane Closures [August 1-5] – KUB contractors will implement shifting lane closures along the section of Neyland Drive between Joan Cronan Way and Lake Loudoun Boulevard daily from 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. August 1-5 as traffic control devices and barricades are removed and the roadway is restriped for a return to the normal traffic flow pattern following a major upgrade project at the Kuwahee Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
