Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(Halls) Norris Freeway Rolling Roadblocks [August 25 & 26]** – KUB crews will implement rolling roadblocks of Norris Freeway between E. Emory Road and Jessilee Drive between 8:30 a.m. – 2 p.m., Tuesday, August 25, and Wednesday, August 26, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Traffic will be stopped in both directions up to 8 times each day for approximately 15 minutes each time to safely pull wire across the roadway. Thursday, August 27, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

**(South Knox) Woodson Drive Road Closure [Overnight, August 25-26]** – KUB crews will implement a closure of Woodson Drive between Alcoa Highway and Oakvale Drive to through traffic overnight from 10 p.m., Tuesday, August 25, through 5 a.m., Wednesday, August 26, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Local traffic access will be maintained, and through traffic should utilize Cherokee Trail and Edington Road. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
