Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(West Knoxville) Oak Ridge Highway Alternating Lane Closures [April 2] – KUB crews will implement alternating lane closures of the curbside lanes of Oak Ridge Highway in both directions between Bobcat Lane and Schaad Road from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., Thursday, April 2, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Both curbside lanes will not be impacted at one time and will alternate as needed to access utility poles, and all inside lanes will remain open. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

<p>Tennessee's Move Over Law requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.</p>
