Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Old City) Patton Street and Willow Street Intersection Closure [October 30 – November 9] – KUB contract crews will close the intersection of Patton Street and Willow Street from 7 a.m. Tuesday, October 30, through 5 p.m., Friday, November 9, as work continues on the water distribution system in the area. As a part of this closure, Patton Street between E. Jackson Avenue and Willow Avenue will also be closed. This closure will be maintained through the weekend due to extensive excavation. Alternate routes include E. Magnolia Avenue, E. Jackson Avenue, E. Summit Hill Drive, and S. Central Street. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
