- Re: Traffic Advisory Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Pleasant Ridge) Pleasant Ridge/Wilson Road/Sanderson Road Intersection Lane Closure [Overnight, January 10-11] – KUB crews will implement a lane closure of the intersection of Pleasant Ridge, Wilson Road, and Sanderson Road overnight from 9 p.m., Thursday, January 10, through 6 a.m., Friday, January 11, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Traffic flow through the intersection will be maintained via flaggers. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Old City) W. Jackson Avenue Lane Closure [Overnight, January 10-11] – KUB crews will reduce a section of W. Jackson Avenue between S. Gay Street and State Street to one alternating lane of traffic from 8 p.m., Thursday, January 10, through 6 a.m., Friday, January 11, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Access to local businesses will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
