Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) Road Closure – Aster Road [March 6-17] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Aster Road between Fenwood Drive and Baugh Road daily, excluding weekends, from 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m., starting Monday, March 6, and lasting through Friday, March 17, as work is performed on the wastewater system in the area. KUB contract crews will also close a short section of Fenwood Drive, at its intersection with Aster Road, intermittently during the listed hours over the course of this work. Alternate routes include Bernhurst Drive, Bluet Road, and Fenwood Drive. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
