Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather

permitting]

(Vestal Area) Willoughby Road/Edington Road Closure [Extended March 26-April 3] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Edington Road between Willoughby Drive and Spruce Drive to through traffic continuously starting at 6 a.m., Tuesday, March 26, through 6 p.m., Wednesday, April 3, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include Cherokee Trail, Candora Road, East End Road, and Young Avenue. Access to businesses and driveways will be maintained. Appropriate signage, flaggers, and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. The impacted section of roadway will reopen over the weekend. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
