Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather

permitting]

(Corryton) Road Closure – Roberts Road [November 2] – KUB crews will close a section of Roberts Road between Bud Hawkins Road and Millertown Pike to through traffic from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., Tuesday, November 2, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include Millertown Pike, Shipe Road, and Bud Hawkins Road. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic, and follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
