Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown Knoxville) S. Gay Street Lane Closure [November 14-19] – KUB crews will implement a lane closure of the northbound, curbside lane and sidewalk of S. Gay Street between Clinch Avenue and Union Avenue from Wednesday, November 14, through 11 p.m., Monday, November 19, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area and roadway restoration is completed. One northbound lane and both southbound lanes will remain open during this time, and the sidewalk will only be closed when crews are present. On-street parking on northbound S. Gay Street will be unavailable. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
