Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown Knoxville) S. Gay Street Lane Closure [Overnight, August 24] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of the southbound, curbside lane of S. Gay Street between Cumberland Avenue and Main Street from 4-7 a.m., on Thursday, August 24, as work is performed on the natural gas distributions system in the area. One southbound lane and both northbound lanes will remain open during this time. The sidewalk on the west side of the street in this area will also be closed during this time. Flaggers and appropriate signage will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
