Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(Sequoyah Hills) Traffic Impacts [March 8-12] – KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated from Monday, March 8, through Friday, March 12, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Cherokee Boulevard closed between Kingston Pike and Cheowa Circle from 7
 a.m. 6 p.m. daily. The turn lane of Kingston Pike to Cherokee Boulevard will
 also be closed during this time, and through traffic will be detoured to Scenic
 Drive.
- Intermittent daily road closures of Lake View Drive between Cheowa Circle and Boxwood Square, Kenilworth Drive between Scenic Drive and Oakhurst Drive
- Intermittent daily lane closures of Woodland Court, and Boxwood Square (access for local residents will be maintained)

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow the onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
