(Sequoyah Hills) Sequoyah Hills Area Traffic Impacts [May 13-17] – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated traffic control measures during work hours, 7 a.m.- 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, May 13-17, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- Daily road closures during work hours:
  - o Bluff View Road between Scenic Drive and Holloway Drive
  - o Holloway Drive between Bluff View Road and Cedar Hill Road
  - o Cherokee Boulevard between Tugaloo Drive and Kenesaw Avenue
- Intermittent lane closures as needed:
  - o Beacon Hill Lane near Sequoyah Avenue
- Intermittent road closures as needed:
  - W. Nokomis Circle between Iskagna Drive and E. Nokomis Circle
  - E. Nokomis Circle between Iskagna Drive and W. Nokomis Circle (will not be closed at the same time as W. Nokomis Drive)
  - Windgate Street between Iskagna Drive and Oakhurst Drive

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
