Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

Sequoyah Hills Area Traffic Impacts [August 19-August 23] – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated traffic control measures during work hours, 7 a.m.- 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, August 19-August 23, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- Intermittent road closures as needed during work hours:
 - Kenesaw Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Taliluna Avenue
 - Navaho Road between Scenic Drive and South Garden Road
 - Bluff View Road between Holloway Drive and Southgate Road
 - Whitlow Avenue between Bluff View Road and Lakeland Drive
 - Agawela Avenue between Taliluna Avenue and Cherokee Boulevard
 - Cherokee Boulevard between Kenesaw Avenue and Southgate Road

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
