Re: Traffic Advisory - Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

Sequoyah Hills Area Traffic Impacts (October 7–11) – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated traffic control measures during work hours, 7 a.m.- 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, October 7–11, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area: • Intermittent road closures as needed during work hours:

o Bluff View Road between Southgate Road and Holloway Drive o Kenesaw Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Taliluna Avenue

(East Knoxville) Road Closures [Weekdays, October 7-18] – KUB contract crews will implement closures weekdays between 7 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. on the below roadways for ongoing wastewater collection system work in the area:

- Michael Street between Holston Drive and Norwalk Avenue
- Norwalk Avenue between Michael Street and Meadow View Road
- Linden Drive between McCalla Avenue and Nash Road
- Nash Road between Pelham Park Road and Spring Hill Road
- N. Park Road between Asheville Highway and Nash Road

All areas will not be impacted at the same time. Local traffic access will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Rocky Hill) Wrights Ferry Road and S. Northshore Drive Lane Closures [Overnight,

October 7-8] – KUB crews will implement lane closures on both Wrights Ferry Road and S. Northshore Drive at their intersection overnight from 10 p.m., Monday, October 7, through 6 a.m., Tuesday, October 8, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Traffic in all directions will be maintained via flaggers. The following night will be used as a rain date if necessary.

(East Knox) Road Closure - Pelham Park Road [October 7-11] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Pelham Park Road near Abner Street to traffic continuously from 7 a.m., Monday, October 7, through 4 p.m., Friday, October 11, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include McCalla Avenue and Pelham Park Road. Local traffic access will be maintained. Signage will be onsite to assist with traffic control. Followup advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas.
