Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Downtown Knoxville) Strong Alley Closure [November 3] – KUB crews will close Strong Alley to pedestrian and vehicle through traffic between Union Avenue and Wall Avenue from 8 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Thursday, November 3, as roadway surface repairs are completed following work on the water distribution system in the area. Flaggers will be on site to assist, and follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Downtown Knoxville) Clinch Avenue Closure [Overnight, November 3-4] — KUB crews will close a one block section of Clinch Avenue between Market Street and S. Gay Street overnight from 9 p.m., Thursday, November 3, through 5 a.m., Friday, November 4, as work is performed on the underground electric system in the area. Alternate routes include Union Avenue and W Church Avenue.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures, including signage, channeling devices, and flaggers, will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
