Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown) Strong Alley Closure [April 17] – KUB crews will close Strong Alley between Union Avenue and Wall Avenue to pedestrian and vehicle traffic from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m., Saturday, April 17, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. Flaggers will be on site to assist, and follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills) Traffic Impacts [April 19-23] – KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated daily 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, April 19, through Friday, April 23, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Intermittent daily road closures of Lake View Drive
- Intermittent daily road closures of Boxwood Square
- Intermittent daily lane closure of Cherokee Boulevard (Northbound lane) between Woodland Drive and Kenesaw Avenue

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow the onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
