Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Marble City) Multiple Traffic Impacts [August 11-13] – KUB crews will implement the below traffic control measures as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area

- 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., Tuesday, August 11, and Wednesday, August 12 – Harry Street closed at Sutherland Avenue & Sutherland Avenue reduced to one alternating lane of traffic at Harry Street
- Overnight from 9 p.m., Wednesday, August 12, through 5 a.m., Thursday, August 13 – Sutherland Avenue closed between Frank Street and Liberty Street. Frank Street and Reagan Avenue should be used as an alternate route.

Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control, and local business access will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
