Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(North Knox) Tazewell Pike Lane Closure (August 5, 2022) – KUB crews will reduce a short section of Tazewell Pike to one alternating lane of traffic between Carter Road and Atkins Road from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. on Friday, August 5, as work is performed on the electric system in the area. Flaggers will be present to assist with maintaining local traffic flow. Appropriate signage will be placed on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
