Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(Downtown) Downtown Lane Closures [Overnight, August 1-2] – KUB crews will implement temporary lane closures in the below locations overnight, between 8:30 p.m., Thursday, August 1, through 5 a.m., Friday, August 2, to allow safe manhole access:

- Summer Place at Locust Street
- Locust Street at W. Summit Hill Drive

All these locations will not be impacted at the same time, and crews will move location as work progresses. Traffic flow around the work zone will be maintained via flaggers, and follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Lonsdale) Texas Avenue Road Closure [Weekdays, August 1-9] – KUB crews will implement a daily road closure of Texas Avenue between Sherman Street and Stonewall Street at the below dates and times as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area:

- August 1-2 from 9 a.m. 3 p.m.
- August 5-9 from 9 a.m. 1 p.m.

Flaggers and signs will be onsite to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
