Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Lonsdale) Texas Avenue Road Closure [Overnight, August 10-11] – KUB crews will implement a road closure of Texas Avenue between Sherman Street and Thomas Street overnight, from 10 p.m., Saturday, August 10, through 6 a.m., Sunday, August 11, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. This closure includes the intersection of Stonewall Street. Alternate routes include Bragg Street, Texas Avenue, Minnesota Avenue, and Sherman Street. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills Area) Traffic Impacts [August 12-16] – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated traffic control measures during work hours, 7 a.m.- 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, August 12-August 16, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- Daily lane closures during work hours:
 - Cherokee Boulevard between Kenesaw Avenue and Southgate Road
 - Cherokee Boulevard between Tugaloo Drive and Kenesaw Avenue
 - Keowee Avenue between Kenesaw Avenue and Talahi Avenue
 - The closure on Kenesaw Avenue will be coordinated with any closure of Cherokee to allow for detours
- Intermittent road closures as needed during work hours:
 - Kenesaw Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Taliluna Avenue
 - Navaho Road between Scenic Drive and South Garden Road
 - Bluff View Road between Holloway Drive and Southgate Road
 - Whitlow Avenue between Bluff View Road and Lakeland Drive
 - Kenesaw Avenue between Woodland Drive and Westerwood Avenue

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
