Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown) Union Avenue Lane Closure [Overnight, March 16-17] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of Union Avenue to one eastbound lane of traffic between Market Street and S. Gay Street overnight from 9 p.m., Tuesday, March 16, through 6 a.m., Wednesday, March 17, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. One lane of eastbound traffic will be maintained. The adjacent sidewalk will also be closed during this time frame. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
