Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown) Union Avenue Lane Closure [May 11] – KUB crews will implement lane closures of Union Avenue between Locust Street and Market Street from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., Tuesday, May 11, to allow safe manhole access in the area. Only the immediate area around the manhole will be closed, and the impacted section of Union Avenue will vary as work progresses. Traffic will be maintained around the work zone. On-street parking in the work zone will also be closed during this time. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
