Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

Various Area Lane Closures [March 17] – On Friday, March 17, KUB contract crews will implement single lane closures at the below locations as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area:

- **Murray Drive** (eastbound lane closed 1800 block of Murray Drive)
- **Sullivan Drive** (eastbound lane closed between Deerfield Road and Gettysburg Road)
- **Paris Road** (southbound lane closed between Northside Drive and Tillery Road)

Work will occur between the hours of 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., and lane closures will not occur on every street at the same time. Crews will move from location to location to complete necessary work. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control, and local traffic access to driveways and businesses will be maintained. Traffic will be alternated through the work zone in the open lane.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
