Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown Knoxville) W. Church Avenue Road Closure [November 29] – KUB crews will close a short section of W. Church Avenue between S. Gay Street and State Street from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Wednesday, November 29, as work is performed on the natural gas and water distribution systems in the area. Alternate routes include S. Gay Street, Union Avenue, State Street, Cumberland Avenue, Main Street, and S. Central Street. Access to local businesses will be maintained, and flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Rain date will be Thursday, November 30, if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
