Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Old City Area) W. Depot Avenue Lane Closure [December 4 – 7] – KUB crews will close a short section of the westbound lane of W. Depot Avenue between Williams Street and N. Gay Street daily from 7 a.m. – 4 p.m., starting Tuesday, December 4 through Friday, December 7, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. The eastbound lane will remain open and will be used to alternate traffic through the work zone. Access to area business will be maintained. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
