Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather

permitting]

(Emory Place) West Magnolia Avenue Lane Closure [May 1-2] – KUB crews will close one lane W. Magnolia Avenue between Conrad Street and N. Gay Street from 8 a.m. – 3 p.m., on both Wednesday, May 1, and Thursday, May 2, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. One lane of eastbound traffic will be maintained. The sidewalk on the south side of the roadway will also be closed during work hours. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
