Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(Downtown) W. Summit Hill Drive Lane/Sidewalk Closures [Overnight, March 10-11]** – KUB crews will close the eastbound curbside lane of traffic on W. Summit Hill Drive between Walnut Street and S. Gay Street overnight starting at 9 p.m., Thursday, March 10, and lasting through 6 a.m., Friday, March 11, as work is performed on the underground electric system. Additionally, the sidewalk will be closed on the south side of W. Summit Hill Drive in this area. The inside eastbound lane, the eastbound left turn lane, and both westbound lanes of traffic will remain open during this period. Follow-up advisories will be issued if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
