Re: Traffic Advisory – Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Old City) W Jackson Avenue Lane & Crosswalk Closures [Overnight, October 27-28] – KUB crews will intermittently close short sections of traffic lanes on W Jackson Avenue between S Gay Street and State Street overnight starting at 9 p.m., Thursday, October 27, through 5 a.m., Friday, October 28, as work is performed on the underground electric system in the area. Additionally, the southside pedestrian crosswalk at the W Jackson Avenue/State Street intersection will be closed. Access will be maintained to Jackson Terminal and area businesses. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
