- Re: Traffic Advisory Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown) W. Summit Hill Drive Lane Closure [Overnight, June 16-17, 18-19] – KUB crews will close the eastbound, curbside lane of W. Summit Hill Drive between Walnut Street and S. Gay Street on the below dates and times as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area:

- Overnight from 8 p.m., Tuesday, June 16, through 6 a.m., Wednesday, June 17
- Overnight from 8 p.m., Thursday, June 18, through 6 a.m., Friday, June 19

One eastbound lane, turn access to S. Gay Street, area cross walks, and both westbound lanes will remain open. On street parking will be closed in the work zone during work hours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
