Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Downtown) Willow Avenue Road Closure [November 17] – KUB crews will close a short section of Willow Avenue between S. Central Street and Patton Street to through traffic and parking from 6 a.m. – 2 p.m., Sunday, November 17, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include S. Central Street, E. Summit Hill Drive, Patton Street, and E. Jackson Avenue. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control, and access to area businesses will be maintained.

Sequoyah Hills Area Traffic Impacts (November 18–22) – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated traffic control measures during work hours, 7 a.m.- 5 p.m., Monday-Friday, November 18–22, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- Intermittent road closures as needed during work hours:
 - Kenesaw Avenue between Taliluna Avenue and Keowee Avenue
 - South Garden Road between Navaho Road and Cherokee Boulevard
 - Woodside Street between Woodland Drive and Iskagna Drive

(East Knoxville) Road Closures [Weekdays, November 18-25] – KUB contract crews will implement closures weekdays between 7:30 a.m. – 6 p.m. on the below roadways for ongoing wastewater collection system work in the area:

- Holston Drive between Martin Luther King Jr., Boulevard and S. Park Street
- Local traffic access will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
