## KUB to Host Public Meeting for Lovell Road Natural Gas Main Relocation Project

KUB will host a public meeting **Thursday, May 18**, starting at **6 p.m. at Providence Church/Worship Center, 1432 Lovell Road**, to discuss an upcoming natural gas relocation project in the Lovell Road area, between Cedardale Lane and Middlebrook Pike.

KUB is currently evaluating possible natural gas main relocation routes ahead of a TDOT/Knox County roadway widening project on Lovell Road.

The public meeting will start with a brief presentation outlining the scope of the project and the construction process. Following the presentation, KUB representatives will be available to talk with customers one-on-one regarding their specific questions.

Surveying and design work is scheduled to begin later in May. Construction is scheduled to start in spring 2018, with completion scheduled for winter 2019.
