Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Roadway Repair [All closures and work

are weather permitting]

(West Knoxville) Middlebrook Pike Lane Closure [March 14] – KUB crews will close a short section of the westbound, curbside lane of Middlebrook Pike between Lonas Drive and Ed Shouse Drive from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Tuesday, March 14, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. One westbound lane and both eastbound lanes will remain open during this time. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control, and access to local businesses will be maintained. Wednesday, March 15, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
