KUB Construction to Temporarily Close Governor Ned McWherter/Riverside Landing Park

Beginning on Monday, September 26, and lasting through late October 2016, Knoxville Utilities Board and its contractor will temporarily close the parking/picnic/playground area, boat ramp, and fishing pier at the Governor Ned McWherter/Riverside Landing Park (1628 Riverside Drive) as upgrades are completed on the wastewater collection system in this area. The nearby James White Greenway will not be impacted by this work or park closure. Signs will be in place to indicate the park closure.
